In 1962, Elliott introduced a groundbreaking new product that became one of its most successful. The Plant Air Package, or PAP, was a small centrifugal air compressor package that supplied oil-free compressed air for industry. Elliott's PAP had several distinct advantages over the reciprocating air compressors then offered by other manufacturers – a smaller footprint, lower maintenance costs and quieter operation. Before selling the product line in 2003, Elliott built and sold 3,800 PAPs. Many of them are still in operation today.

In 2010 we celebrate the 100th anniversary of the foundation of the original Elliott Company.
